ACULEATISSIMA (Thin leaf wattle) Low form. 0.2-0.4m Fl June-nov. WD, inc heavy clay.  
BAILEYANA (Cootamundra Wattle) 5-6m wd Golden yellow fl July-Sept.....(2)  
BAILEYANA PURPUREA as above, purple new growth

DRUMMONDI (Drummond Wattle) 60cm-2m WD prefers some shade, yellow fl July-Oct  
ELATA (Cedar Wattle) 10-20m x 5m most soil incl heavy, pale yellow fl Dec-March.....(3)  
FLORIBUNDA (Gassamer Wattle) 3-7m most soil incl wet, yellow fl July-Sept.....(1)  
GLANDULICARPA (Hairy Pod Wattle) 1-2m WD, Ornamental, Fl July-Oct  
GLAUDESCENS (Coast myall) 15-20m. Bright yellow fl July-Oct. Young growth poisonous.  
GLAUOPTERA (0.5-1.5m x 2-3m wide) WD, ornamental foliage, Fl Aug-Nov  
HORRIDULA 60cm-1.5m light to med soil, cream-yellow fl May-Aug  
HOWITTA (Sticky Wattle) 4-8m WD Pendulous habit pale yellow fl Aug-Dec.....(2)  
ITEAPHYLLA (Flinders Range Wattle) 3-5m WD Weeping blue-green foliage, fl Mar-Sept.....(2)  
LASIOCARPA 60cm-2m WD dense small shrub, yellow fl June-Oct  
LEIOPHYLLA 2-3m med shrub similar to A. Pycnantha, yellow fl Aug-Nov  
LITTOREA 1-3m. Pale yellow fl Aug-Nov. Good drainage essential. Native to sand dunes in south west WA , it good for stabilising dunes.  
LONGIFOLIA (Sallow Wattle) up to 10m yellow fl July-Aug.....(1)  
MELANOXYLON (Blackwood) 10-20m prefers moist soil, cream fl July-Oct.....(3)  
MUCRONATA (Narrow Leaf Wattle) 2-5m Adaptable, Yellow fl Aug-Nov  
MYRTIFOLIA (Myrtle Wattle) 1-3m WD can be short lived, pale yellow fl July-Oct.....(2)  
MEARNSII (Black Wattle) med tree to 15m cream fl Sept-Dec  
PODALYRIFOLIA (Mount Morgan Wattle) 3-5m good drainage, yellow fl July-Oct.....(3)  
PRAVISSIMA (Ovens Wattle) 3-7m lighter soil, yellow fl Aug-Oct.....(3)  
PRAVISSIMA mini prostrate Ground cover, yellow flowers in winter (Only 5" pot @ \$4)  
PROMINENS (Golden Rain Wattle) 5-15m Most soils, Yellow fl Aug-Oct  
PYCNANTHA (Golden Wattle) 4-8m WD yellow/golden-yellow fl July-Oct.....(2)  
RETINOIDES (Wirilda) 4-8m Most soil incl wet, Yellow fl Nov-Jan & sporadic.....(2)  
STRICTA (Hop Wattle) 2-5m x 2-4m WD pale yellow fl May-Oct.....(2)  
TRUNCATA 1-3m WD, Pale yellow fl June-Sept Good coastal plant on alkaline soil.....(2)

**ACMENA SMITHII** (Lilly Pilly) 10-13m Most soil except wet, Purple berries  
**ADENANTHOS** WD soil essential, usually only available in 15cm pot @ \$5  
**ARGYREA** 1-1.5m small shrub, reddish-pink fl Aug-Oct, WD, full sun/part shade  
**BARBITERA** (Hairy Jug Flower) 60cm-1m red flowers, fine silky hairs  
**CUNNINGHAMII** to 1.5m, low spreading shrub, WD  
**DETMOLDII** 2-4m, med shrub Yellow & orange fl, prefers part shade  
**ILETICOLIS** 1-2m Pink& cream fl WD, warm location  
**OBOVATA** 1m x1m Tubular scarlet flower 4cm long May-Sept & sporadic  
**MEISNERI** 1-2m. hairy leaves. WD, Prefers part shade. Flowers reddish-mauve to 4cm.. (3)  
**PUNGENS** 2-3m. dark pink fl. 4cm long, Aug-Nov  
**SERICEA** (Woolly Bush) 2-7m ornamental foliage, small red flower to 4cm long.....(1)

**NANA** (Stunted Sheoak) 2-4m x 1-2m Most soil, Dense small shrub  
**PALUDOSA** (Swamp Sheoak) 1m x1-2m Small shrub, Needs good drainage and sun  
**TORULOSA** (Rose Sheoak) 7-12m Most soils and conditions, Rusty tinged foliage May-June..(2)  
**VERTICULATA** (Coastal Drooping Sheoak) 4-10m x 3-6m Handles most conditions (1\*)

**HUEGELII** (Native Hibiscus) 1.5-2.5m WD light/heavy soil, semi shade/sun, needs regular pruning. Mauve flowers  
 "West Coast Gem" 2-3m x 1-1.5m deep purple fl, WD posi., full sun/part shade  
**HAKEIFOLIA** "Elle Marie" to 2m x 1.5, yellow flower, brown centre, fullsun/part shade  
 "Melissa Ann" to 2m x 1.5m, mauve fl, full sun/part shade

**ALYXIA BUXIFOLIA** 30cm-1.5m WD. white fl. followed by red berries(1\*) (only in 6"pots @ \$6)

**COSTATA** (Smooth Bark Apple Mrytle) 13-20m Most soil except poorly drained.....(2)

**BAECKEA LINIFOLIA** Weeping Baeckea 1-3m x 0.5-2m, Any position, small white flowers  
**BANKSIA** Most Banksias grow in well drained soil that is low in nutrients, in an open sunny position. Fertilizer should be slow release with low phosphorous levels.  
 Limited varieties in 2"/forestry tubes. Most varieties in 7.5cm(3") @ \$2 ea, or 15cm pots..  
**ASHBYI** 3-6m WD orange cone  
**ATTENUATA** dwarf .5m  
**BAUERI** (Woolly Banksia/Possum Banksia) 2-5m WD yellow cone with grey-mauve tips.....(3)  
**BAXTERI** (Baxter's Banksia) 3-4m WD yellow-green cone.....(2)  
**BLECHNIFOLIA** prostrate, WD reddish-pink cone  
**BROWNII** (Feather Leafed Banksia) 3-6m WD reddish brown cones.....(2)  
**BURDETTI** (Burdett's Banksia) 3-6m WD orange cones

**MEISNERI** 1-1.5m x 1-2m part/full sun, yellow flower March-Nov  
**MENZIESII** Dwarf. to 2.5m.  
**NUTANS** var *nutans* (Nodding Banksia) 1-2m WD Brown Cone  
**NUTANS** var.*cernuella*.2-3m Differs from var. *nutans* by smaller fl & fruit.  
**OBLONGIFOLIA** (B. *Asplenifolia*) 60cm-2m Sandy soil, pale yellow cone.....(1)  
**LITTORALIS** (Swamp Banksia) 5-13m WD yellow cone.....(2)  
**OCCIDENTALIS** (Red Swamp Banksia) 3-7m Most soil incl wet, red cone  
**PALUDOSA** (Swamp Banksia) 60cm-1.5m WD acid soil, pale yellow cone  
**PETIOLARIS** prostrate x up to 2mspread WD , pink cone  
**PRAEMORSA** 2-5m WD neutral soil Moroon Or yellow flowering forms.....(1)  
**PRIONOTES** (Acorn Banksia) 5-12m WD grey-orange cone.....(2)  
**PULCHELLA** (Teasel Banksia) 1-1.5m WD slightly acid soil, bright yellow cone.....(3)  
**QUERCIFOLIA** (Oak Leaved Banksia) 2-4m Most soil incl wet, orange-brown cone  
**REPENS** (Creeping Banksia) 30-60cm WD yellow-brown cone  
**ROBUR** 60cm-2m WD Tolerates inundation, greenish yellow cone  
**SCABRELLA** to 2m WD cream cone  
**SCEPTRUM** 2-7m WD slightly acid soil, yellow cone  
**SEMINUDA** tree to 20m WD deep red flower form, part shade /full sun.  
**SERRATA** (Saw Banksia) 10-16m WD neutral soil, greenish yellow cone.....(2)  
**SERRATIFOLIA** 3-5m acid soil incl boggy, greenish -yellow cone.....(2)  
**SOLANDRI** 2-8m. Grey-brown to bronze fl. sept-dec. WD but not dry, prefers part shade  
**SPECIOSA** (Showy Banksia)WD tolerates alkaline soil, cones have yellow stamens.....(2)  
**SPHAEROCARPA** (Fox Banksia) 1-3m WD bronze yellow cone.....(3)  
**SPINULOSA** (Hairpin Banksia) shrub to 3m x 3m. WD acid soil, golden cone, full sun/part shade  
**SPINULOSA** Dwarf form. 1-1.5m x 1-1.5m. (only in 6" pots @ \$6)  
**SPINULOSA** "Schnapper Point" 0.4m x 1-1.5m. Fl. april-sept.Good pot plant.(only in 6" @ \$6)  
**SPINULOSA** Red flowering form. 1.5-3m. Yellow flower with red styles.  
**SPINULOSA** var. *Collina* (Hill Banksia) 2-4m.  
**TELMATIAEA** to 2m tolerates poor drainage, brown cone  
**TRICUSPIS** 2-5mYellow fl. heads apr-sept.WD

**VICTORIAE** (Woolly Orange Banksia) WD neutral soil, orange cone with pink tip  
**VIOLACEA** 1-1.5m sandy, slightly acid soil, violet cone

**DECUSSATA** 2-3m.Dark red flower jan-apr & sporadic.WD, Full sun/ part shade.  
**SPARSA** (Gravel Bottlebrush) 1-2m WD or damp, full sun, fiery red flower

BEAUFORTIA TORULOSUS 2-3m. Red fl with gold anthers. WD. Full sun/ part shade.....(3)

VALIDUS 2-3m. Red fl with gold anthers.WD. Full sun/part shade.....(2)

VILLOSUS 1-2.5m. Red fl with gold anthers.WD. Full sun/ part shade

**BLANDFORDIA GRANDIFLORA** (Christmas Bells) 0.3-0.6m. Tubular red flower with yellow tip.

### **BORONIA**

●CLAVATA 1.5-2.5m Adaptable incl wet soil, pale yellow-green flower.....(2)

●DENTICULATA 1-2.5m Most soil, best in partial shade, usually pink flower

●HETEROPHYLLA (Red Boronia) 1.5-2.5m Most soil, reddish pink flower

●MEGASTIGMA 'Heaven Scent' (Brown Boronia) to 1m. compact form. Scented brown flowers  
aug-oct. It grows best in permanently moist, well drained soil. Grows in full sun  
if the root system is protected by mulching or rocks.

●MEGASTIGMA "lutea" 1-1.5m Moist WD soil, greenish-yellow flower

●MUELLERI "Sunset Serenade" 60cm Moist WD soil, prefers part shade, pale pink fl (8" only)

### **BOSSIAEA**

CINEREA small shrub to 1.5m. Yellow pea fl with red markings. Prefers WD in part shade (3)

LINOPHYLLA to 2m. Yellow fl with red keel. WD IN full sun/ part shade.

### **BRACHYCHITON**

ACERIFOLIUS (flame tree) 10-30m. In southern Australia this is a small  
spreading tree. Bright red fl oct-mar. Sheds leaves before flowering.(10" pots only)

POPULNEUS (Kurrajong) 6-15m. Easily grown on most soils. Cream or pink fl oct-feb.(8"pot )

●MULTIFIDA (Rock Daisy) 15cm WD sun/partial shade, mauve daisy flower

●MULTIFIDA "Dilitata" 15cm WD sun/partial shade, compact, hardy, bluish daisy flower

**BRACHYSEMA LANCEOLATUM** (Swan River Pea) 60cm-1.5m WD red pea flower

**BRACTEANTHA BRACTEATA** "Cockatoo" white flower (previously included in Helichrysum)

**BURSARIA SPINOSA** 3-6m Most soil except badly drained, compact thorny shrub

**CALLITRIS CANESCENS** 3-6m x 2-4m small erect tree, hardy.....(1)

HUGELII (White cypress pine/ Murray Pine) 15-25m x 5-10m WD Slender erect tree.

Sometimes known as Callitris Glaucophylla

OBLONGA (Tasmanian Cypress Pine) 2-8m x 1-3m shrub or sm tree

PREISSI (Slender Cypress Pine) Green leaf form. 8-20m Med slender erect tree. (1)

RHOMBOIDEA (Port Jackson Pine) 3-6m x 2-3m shrub or sm tree

●**CALOCEPHALUS BROWNII** (Cushion Bush) to 1m, silvery foliage.....(1\*)

**CALLISTEMON** All Callistemon varieties are in Group (2) coastal exposure rating

●CITRINUS ANZAC 1m x 3m across most soils, white flower

●CITRINUS BURGUNDY 2-4m most soil

●CITRINUS EASTLAND 2-4m Most soil, mauve bottle brush

●CITRINUS "EWAN ROAD" to 1.5m x 2m across Dark red flower autumn & spring

●CITRINUS KING'S PARK SPECIAL 3-4m Most soil, Long red bottlebrushes

●CITRINUS MAUVE MIST 2-4m Most soil, deep pink flower

●CITRINUS "PERTH PINK" 2-3m. Pink flower spring & summer.

●CITRINUS "Red Clusters" 2-3m. Clusters of red flowers nov-jan & sporadic.

●CITRINUS REEVES PINK 2-4m pink flower with gold anthers

●CITRINUS SPLENDENS (C. Endeavour) to 4m Most soil, red brushes with white tiops

●CITRINUS "Violaceus" 2.5-5m Most soil, Light purple bottlebrushes

●GUYRA (Candy Pink) 2-5m Most soils, pendulous habit, Deep pink flower.

INJUNE shrub to 2m. Silver grey foliage, pale pink flowers

MACROPUNCTATUS (Scarlet Bottlebrush) 2-4m Most soil incl wet

MONTANUS 2-4m adaptable, New growth pink, Red bottlebrush

●PALLIDUS 2-3m. Yellow flower, most soil.

●PALLIDUS "Mt. Oberon" 1.5-2m. Yellow flower.

PINK CHAMPAGNE to 3m full sun

PURPLE SPLENDOUR 2-4m x 2-2.5m full sun/part shade

SALIGNUS 5-7m Most soils, Hardy, Cream or red flowering forms, pendulous habit

●SALIGNUS Violet Rose Form (C. Eureka) 2-3m Most soils, Mauve flower

SPECIOSUS 2-3m Most soils, upright shrub, deep scarlet brush Reddish-pink flowers

TINAROO DAZZLER 2-3m x to 4m red flower tipped gold, full sun/part shade

VIMINALIS 5-7m Most soil, weeping habit, red bottlebrushes

●VIMINALIS CAPTAIN COOK 1.5-2m compact shrub, Most soil, Red bottlebrushes

●VIMINALIS DAWSON RIVER to 10m, most soil, crimson bottlebrush

●VIMINALIS HARKNESS (Gawler Hybrid) 3-6m Red flower in spring & summer

●VIMINALIS "LITTLE JOHN" 1m x 1m. Burgundy flowers

VIMINALIS " Mr. Foster"

- VIMINALIS PROLIFIC 3-5m Red flower weeping habit

### **CALOTHAMNUS**

ASPER (Rough Net Bush) 6-9' adaptable, red flower

GILESII upright medium shrub, fl july-feb bright red with gold anthers.Best in full sun. (Only in 5")

GRACILIS 0.5-1m dark red fl, WD, full sun/part shade

TORULOSIS 2-3m red flow with gold anthers Aug-Sept, WD, full sun/part shade

QUADRIFIDIS (Common Net Bush) 6-12' red flower in one-sided spikes.....(2)

- QUADRIFIDIS Yellow Flower Form, to 1m, low spreading shrub

VALIDUS 2-3m red fl with gold anthersAug- Jan WD full sun/part shade

VILLOSUS 1-3m red fl with gold anthers, WD, full sun/part shade

### **CALYTRIX**

ALPESTRIS 2-3m. Flowers pink buds opening to white.Prefers moist WD soil, &partial sun.

SULLIVANII 2-3m x 1-3m Shrub with white fl aug-nov.WD, prefers part shade.From Grampians.

TETRAGONA compact .5m White or pink flowering forms.

**CAREX APPRESSA** (Tall Sedge) to 0.8m good in boggy positions

**CASUARINA** Also see Allocasuarina

CRISTATA (Cas. Lepidophloia) 25-60' prefers heavysoil.....(2)

CUNNINGHAMIANA (River She-Oak) 30-50' most soil incl. wet.....(2)

OBESA (Cas. Glauca, Swamp She-Oak, Grey Bulloke) 30-40' wet sites.....(2)

**CARPOBROTUS ROSSI** prostrate x 2-3m. Purple fl aug-feb & sporadic Hardy. WD .....(1\*)

Good for sandbinding. Commonly called pigface or karkala.(in 3" @ \$1 ea)

### **CHAMELAUCIUM**

- AXILLARE (Esperance Wax) 1-2m White fl nov-feb.WD. Fullsun/part shade.

- CILIATUM 2-3' moist WD soil, white flower aging to red Sept-Nov.

- UNCINATUM (Geraldton Wax) 2-5m. Pale pink fl form

"Purple Pride" reddish purple flowers.

- CHORILAENA QUERCIFOLIA** 1-4m.Medium shrub.Cream & reddish fl. Prefers moist WD soil in part shade.Good screen plant, & appeals to nectar feeding birds.

### **CHORIZEMA**

- CHORDATUM (Heart Leaf Flame Pea) to 3' & spreading, WD semi-shade, orange pea flower

- RHOMBEUM to 1' WD partial shade, reddish pea flower

### **CHRYSOCEPHALUM** (Helichrysum)

BAXTERI (White everlasting) 0.2-0.5m. Dwarf perennial herb. Prefers moist WD soil.

### **CLEMATIS**

- ARISTATA (Austral Clematis,Goat's Beard) climber, white flower

- MICROPHYLLA (Small Leaved Clematis) climber, WD, greenish-creamflower.....(1)
